Thank you for choosing our Calypso planter.


The planter is made of **easy-care** and **weatherproof plastic**.

The **integrated irrigation system** provides optimum care for plants. The planter's **wheels** make transportation a cinch.


The assembly instructions are provided below. You also need a **6** - **10 mm drill bit**. Much of the assembly process involves simply interlocking the individual parts



























Planting and care instructions

- Select suitable pot plants for your Calypso's location. Is it sunny, shady, etc.?
- The best time to plant your plants in the planter is after the lce Saints. If there is still a risk of frost, cover the plants with garden fleece or place them by a sheltered wall.
- Find the **right balance when watering** and pay attention to the individual needs of your pot plants.
- Fertilise your plants regularly.
- Keep an eye on your pot plants and regularly check them for pests and diseases.
- Protect your plants from frost by storing them in cool, bright rooms during the winter. The ideal temperature should be between 5 and 12°C.


